Hi Steve - Unless this project has a Federal agency involved (like through funding or a permit), you don't need to do anything further regarding northern long-eared bats. If this project happens to need a permit from the Corps of Engineers, they will "consult" with my office regarding the tree clearing using a streamlined process under the Federal Endangered Species Act. All the Corps needs from you is the amount of tree clearing.

If there is no Federal agency involved with this project, there is nothing further you need to do. I am in the office today if you have further questions and want to give me a call. I've also been playing telephone tag with Walter Pelkey from your office. I think he has the same bat question for a project in Wells.
