Lisa GA	Chapter 6 - Land Use Policies and Strategies	5	15 & 16	Add from Maine's Growth Management Program includes "Prevent inappropriate development in natural hazard areas, including flood plains and areas of high erosion." This is not mentioned in Wells comprehensive plan and should be included. Include: Assess any proposed project for long-term function under the effects of climate change."

Again, this part of the growth management plan is not mentioned, although the Wells comp plan recommended explaining how the Maine GMP was used as a resource.
